



Radio Passport for AE 4100 / AE 4180 with programming "40/40"

This CB radio with 40 channels FM and 40 channels AM may be used in different European countries and is notified according to the provisions of the R&TTE directive of the European Union. The radio corresponds to harmonised EU standards EN 300 135-2 and EN 300 433-2. The manufacturer declares herewith, that this radio is allowed to be used according to the country specific conditions in following table:

Important note:

Please respect the licence conditions and do not use the radio without licence, where necessary. For travelling with Your radio into other countries You will need a “ **Circulation card** ”, available from CB Clubs or the radio authority in Your home country.

Notes for users of AE 4100 or AE 4180 with 40/40 channels in Germany:

The latest model **AE 4100** and the identical **AE 4180** with 40 CH AM and FM replaces the former special German 40/12 version (AE 4100 “40/12”), because the European Standard and the R&TTE directive allow use of harmonised equipment and the **former technical restriction to CH 4-15 in AM is no more requested**. But **operation** of these radios in AM mode remains **restricted to CH 4-15**.
